## **“California Proposition 65” (CP65)**

Dear valued customer

Thank you for your inquiry regarding KVV compliance with California Proposition 65, formerly known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, which was enacted as a ballot initiative in November 1986.

The proposition helps protect the state's drinking water sources from being contaminated with approximately 1000 chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm (“Proposition 65 Substances”), and requires businesses to inform Californians about exposures to Proposition 65 Substances.

KVV does not typically manufacture consumer products. Consumer products are defined as products for the personal use, consumption or enjoyment of a consumer. Hence our products are out of scope of this regulation.

Furthermore, any trace elements such as Pb, Cd or Ni in the copper conductor (ETP1) or for example Carbon Black [CAS.No.1333-86-4] in semi conductive compounds are in bound form in the conductor or insulations of cables! For this reason the conformity to the CP65 in this regard can be confirmed for all KVV cable types!
